Recycled steel

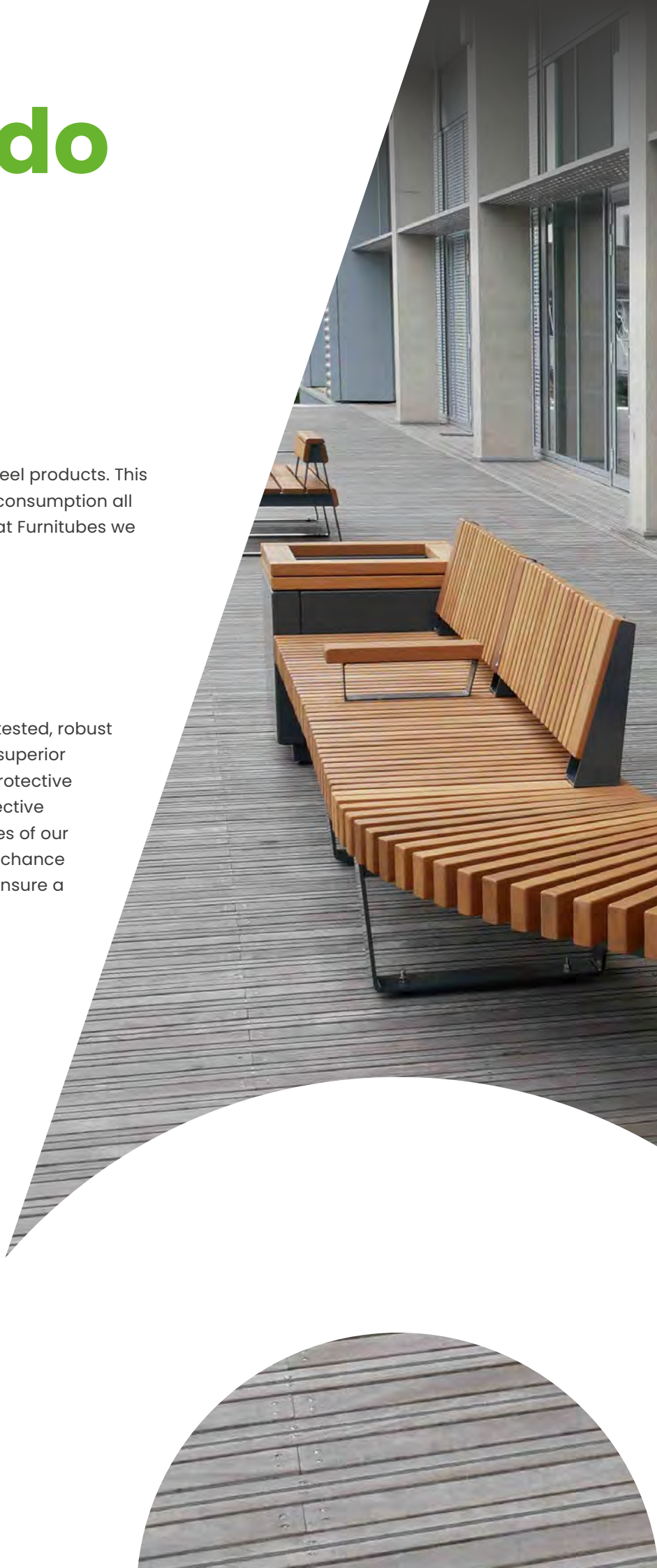
We only use recycled steel to produce our steel products. This significantly reduces our waste and energy consumption all the while maintaining our high standards – at Furnitubes we never compromise on quality.

Triple process coating

Triple Process Coating is our independently tested, robust finish system for steel products. Providing a superior finish quality to galvanising with the same protective properties, it combines shot blasting, a protective primer and a PPC finish coat. The three stages of our triple process coating work to eliminate any chance for adhesion issues and uneven coating to ensure a smooth high quality outcome.

FSC timber

Outdoor furniture should be inviting and it should be fit for purpose, but not at the expense of our planet – which is why we produce our products with FSC sourced Iroko hardwood. Classified as “very durable”, Iroko is known to last more than 25 years making it extremely durable, stable and cost effective in the long run. As standard, we offer a smooth planed finish that will typically fade to silver-grey within 12 months. To retain its original colouration, ask our team about the treatments and finishes we offer.
